- Light and shadow, is it out of fashion?
- Understanding colour in the deepest sense – what the Masters say.
- The principles of architectural photography.
- Portrait photography, tips from the Masters.
- The etiquette of photography – paparazzi, reportage or the silent observer.

Depending upon weather conditions, we will do some practical portrait photography either on location or in the studio. The workshop will be held at **Inspiral Designs Office** in West London.
