“Islamic Finance amid Global Financial Turmoil – Its implications for Japan”

Islamic finance, which prohibits the increase of money itself and stipulates a real economic transaction, has attracted more attention in the wake of the global economic crisis. To construct a bridge of investment between the Middle East/Islamic world and developed or Asian countries, the United Kingdom, Singapore, Hong Kong, and Korea are advancing approaches to Islamic finance. Even Japan, whose responses have lagged behind those of these countries, has started to take action to enter into insurance and investment trust businesses conforming to the Islamic system. Amid increasing interest in the future growth of the market including bond issuing and project finance, the Nikkei Islamic Finance Symposium will be held by bringing together high-ranking finance officials and experts of each country. We hope that this symposium will provide an opportunity to discuss issues such as the Islamic finance system, the current status and challenges of the market, and important points to note for Japan to deal with it.
